Texas Alliance for Life Introduces Pro-Life Voters Hub

AUSTIN—Texas Alliance for Life introduced today an online **Pro-Life Voters Hub** designed to assist Texas voters in electing pro-life leaders.

In addition to a candidate survey and a list of statewide endorsements, the site contains a unique **Personalized Voter Guide** that allows voters to enter their address and retrieve a list of endorsed candidates who will appear on their particular Republican or Democratic primary election ballot.

“We want to make it as easy on voters as possible,” says Joe Pojman, Ph.D., executive director of Texas Alliance for Life. “Nothing else exists in Texas that can give voters this kind of particular information in such a direct manner.”

Texas Alliance for Life also provides a guide for getting involved in precinct conventions, which are held after the polls close at 7 p.m. on Primary Election Day (March 2), and information about Proposition 5 on the Republican primary ballot, which supports the creation of a pro-life Sonogram Bill.
