

Get the ultrasound bill passed!



The Texas Legislature is currently meeting in Austin through June 1.

Please ask your state elected officials to support the ultrasound bill, SB 182 in the Senate and HB 36 in the House.



These bills will require abortion facilities to make available to a woman the ultrasound image of the unborn child before she consents to an abortion.

It is critical that you contact your state elected officials in the next few days—the Governor, Lt. Governor, and especially your state senator and representative—by phone or email.

The Texas House and Senate are considering this badly needed bill. Performing an ultrasound and showing the image to a woman is simply the recognized standard of care for any obstetrics procedure, including abortion. Why should women be denied this information before an abortion when they are not denied it in any other type of Ob/Gyn medicine?

The testimony on the second page was given by Dr. Mikeal Love, a board certified Ob/Gyn physician who recently gave expert testimony before the House Committee on State Affairs on this bill. According to Dr. Love:

Ultrasound is currently the standard of care in Obstetrics and Gynecology whether it is for dating a pregnancy, documenting ovarian cysts, or terminating a pregnancy.
