

Stop the health care abortion mandate

This newsletter helps you make one contact a month to policy-makers to protect innocent human lives.



Summary

This month we ask you to contact and ask **your** U.S. Representative in Washington, D.C., to **oppose** H.R. 3200, the health care bill, unless there is an explicit exclusion of abortion coverage. Without an abortion exclusion, H.R. 3200 would be an enormous health care abortion mandate and would be the greatest expansion of abortion in the U.S. since *Roe v. Wade*.

Background

As this goes to press, the U.S. House of Representatives is expected to vote on the health care bill after Labor Day. Now is the time to contact your U.S. Representative in Washington, D.C.

Your call, email, or fax to your U.S. Representative will only take a few minutes. But it make a huge difference and save countless lives from the tragedy of abortion.

Abortion is not health care. Only in a evil world can killing an innocent child be seen as health care. The health care plans backed by the Obama White House and Speaker Nancy Pelosi, including H.R. 3200, would allow unelected bureaucrats to mandate the new government health care plan, virtually all private health care plans, and Medicaid to pay for abortion as a covered benefit. You would not have an option to buy a health care plan that did not cover abortion. Your health care premiums would be used without your consent to fund abortion. And your tax dollars would fund abortion in Medicaid.

H.R. 3200 would also allow the same bureaucrats to strike down Texas' protective laws such as parental consent, informed consent, and state bans on abortion funding. This would be a covert Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA).

Without an abortion exclusion, H.R. 3200 would require public and private health care plans to pay for abortions. For the first time in 30 years, Medicaid would pay for abortion.

H.R. 3200 would also strike down state laws in Texas that require parental consent and informed consent. Only an explicit ban on abortion coverage would ensure that these would not happen.

Abortion and other forms of killing are not health care. Please do not force me to pay to kill unborn children with my health care premiums and with my tax dollars.
