Central Health (formerly the Travis County Healthcare District) is currently funding abortions with Travis county property tax dollars. The Board is considering approving an annual budget that includes a whopping \$450,000 for elective abortions, same as the previous budget. The abortions — as many as 1,000 during the next twelve months — will be performed on demand on healthy women with healthy unborn babies. No medical reason or referral is required.

The Central Health Board will consider the budget — including the abortion funding — at its meeting on Wednesday, September 15. After that, the five members of the Travis County Commissioners Court will vote on approving the budget on Tuesday, September 21.

Our research has revealed that the Central Health is the only political body to fund elective abortion in the State of Texas. The State Legislature does not fund elective abortions, nor do any cities, counties, or health care districts.
