### Update on Federal Legislative Issues

Thanks for all your phone calls, emails, and faxes to members of Congress. Our efforts have paid off. In 2007, there were no reversals of pro-life policies, despite vows to do so by the newly-elected anti-life leadership in the U.S. House and Senate.

Attempts to fund embryonic stem cell research failed (thanks especially to a veto by President Bush). The Freedom of Choice Act did not pass. There was no reversal of the pro-life Mexico City

Policy, which prevents our tax dollars from going to organizations like International Planned Parenthood which perform or do referral for abortions. The SCHIP program continues to allow Texas to provide medical insurance for unborn children of low-income moms (again, thanks to a Bush veto). However, expect anti-life forces to redouble their efforts in 2008.
